RULES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

1. Participants must be the member of SAAPD (Staff and PG's) .
 2. Faculty delegates can do presentation in one of the themes of 3 zones.
 3. Abstracts must be original research and should not have been published in any other journal or presented at any conference previously.
 4. Post graduates can present only in theme of yellow zone.
 5. One person can present only one paper as a lead presenter.
 6. Author and HOD in case of students (Post graduates) are responsible for the content in the final submission of scientific presentation.
 7. All the abstracts submitted by students must be authorized and countersigned by the Heads of the department
 8. All abstracts must be submitted through Email (covdentkims@gmail.com) Only abstracts submitted within the specified deadline will be considered for audio- visual presentation by the Scientific Committee.
 9. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited & the presenter will be disqualified if found guilty of plagiarism.

YellowZone (PG): Original Research/ Case Report/ Meta analysis and systemic review

ABSTRACT FORMAT

1. Language: English, Font size: 12,Font type: Times New Roman,Spacing: Single line
2. Title: This should be as brief as possible and typed in sentence case (all letters in lowercase except the first letter of the first word of the title)
3. Author : The affiliation details of author; department, institution/hospital, city/town, state (if relevant) and country should be included.
4. Abstract Text Word Limit: Not more than 250 words (title, authors and affiliation details are excluded).
5. The abstract should include SAAPD membership number and Registration number. The abstract should follow the following structure:
6. For Original Research: Background/ Introduction, Objectives, Study Design, Methodology, Results, Conclusions
7. For Case Report: Introduction, Case report, Clinical significance
8. For Meta Analysis and Systemic Review: Introduction, Results, Conclusion

Audio-Visual Presentation Guidelines

1. Participants should send audio visual recording of their presentation only after their abstract has been approved by the scientific committee.
2. Presentation should be on Microsoft Power-point 2007 or latest.
3. First slide should contain SAAPD membership number, conference registration number / coded number received on abstract approval. Title of the presentation. (background colour of slide should be of respective zone colour)
4. Presenters should strictly adhere to the allotted time.
5. Only one person can be a presenter.
6. The identity of the author/presenter, department and institutional background should not be revealed. Any attempt to reveal identity will attract disqualification from the competitive category.
7. Maximum time allotted is 8 minutes for Faculty and 6 minutes for Post Graduates.
8. The decision of the scientific team will be final and binding.
